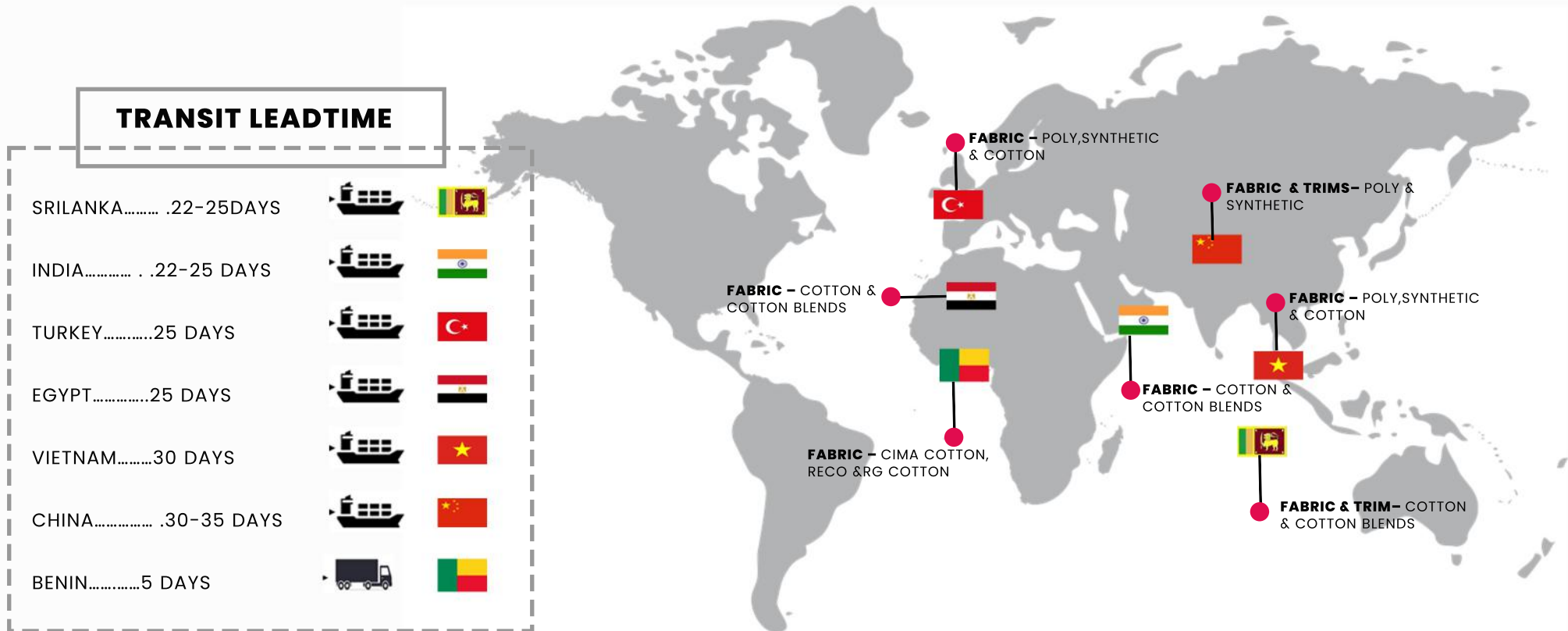
FABRIC PROCUREMENT: 3–6 weeks (depending on origin).

CYNDEX IS DEDICATED TO MINIMIZING ITS ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT. WE IMPLEMENT SUSTAINABLE PRACTICES SUCH AS:

USE OF ECO-FRIENDLY MATERIALS: Prioritizing organic and recycled materials in our designs.

ETHICAL SOURCING: Partnering with suppliers who adhere to fair labour practices and ethical standards.

REDUCING WASTE: Implementing measures to minimize waste throughout the production process.

ROOF COOLING SYSTEM: Borehole water through sprinklers installed on roof of factory building to give a cooling effect in the factory floor to enhance productivity.

Cyndex is in the process of exploring the use of off-cuts to produce pillows and in Sustainable fashion to minimize waste.
